# **English**

# **Daily Reviews**

#### Weeks 1 & 2 focus:

- Writing complex words read in Nevermoor in simple, compound and complex sentences
- Developing understanding of how to use words in different tenses in a sentence such as respect, respectful and respected

# Phonics/Word Knowledge/Morphology

#### Weeks 1 & 2 focus:

- Build phonological, morphological and vocabulary knowledge of linked ANZAC Day
- Build phonological, morphological and vocabulary knowledge of words that use the prefix trans

#### Dictation

## Weeks 1 & 2 focus:

- applying the letter patterns practiced in phonics and word knowledge lesson to spell new words they hear when spoken
- Weekly dictation sentences to apply phonological knowledge to write simple sentences and questions.

# **Handwriting**

#### Weeks 1 & 2 focus:

- Developing consistency with letter size when using 8mm lines
- Practicing the formation of commas, talking marks and questions marks
- Practicing Victorian Cursive script joined and unjoined when writing modelled passages of text

# **Fluency**

## Weeks 1 & 2 focus:

- Reading class mentor text aloud to different partners to develop confidence
- Tracking the reader using strategies such as echo reading and responding to questions
- Giving feedback to a peer about their reading rate, accuracy and expression

# Reading /Vocabulary/Comprehension

# Weeks 1 & 2 focus:

- Recording the language Jessica Townsend (Nevermoor author) uses that links to the fantasy genre
- Using text clues to compare fictional and real-life representations in our mentor text 'Nevermoor'
- Summarising important events characters and/or chapters in a text, using precise information and evidence from the text
- Tracking reading by responding to teaching prompts and questions
- Having thoughtful discussions about the character motives in a text
- Close reading a short text and responding to comprehension and inferential questions about ANZAC Day

# Reading

#### Weeks 1 & 2 focus:

 Repeat reading our Nevermoor text to increase our work knowledge and improve decoding more complex words

# Weeks 1 & 2 focus:

- Recording facts from short videos
- Developing research questions
- Writing topic sentences



# English: How you can help your child at home:

- Watch documentaries and discuss the facts
- Ask your child to summarise a book, article or movie in just 3 to 4 sentences
- Read with you child

# **Maths**

## Weeks 1 & 2 focus:

- Using a vertical algorithm to solve multiplication of 2- and 3-digit whole numbers
- Developing oral and written fluency when reciting maths facts (1 minute maths drills each day)
- Representing fractions as picture, models and as symbols
- Identifying fractions of a quantity using hands on materials
- Identifying and recognising equivalent fractions using a fraction wall to match fraction part
- Using multiplication to identify and create equivalent fractions
- Converting fractions to decimals using division (extension)



# Maths: How you can help your child at home:

- Discuss when fractions are used in your environment, such as when cutting a pizza or for chocolate bars
- Discuss how recipes use fractions to explain how much ingredients to add
